I have pleasure in inviting you to join the London Stedfast Association. Our Association was founded in 1983, and you would be joining about 650 other members. Today the Association is generally known and referred to as the - **LSA**.

All members receive the Association magazine – the **ONLOOKER** by post. The aim is to produce 3 issues a year in full colour with regular articles and plenty of news and pictures. We hold an Annual Church Service and General Meeting normally at Wesley's Chapel London. The LSA has social sections, Bugle and Brass Bands, Concert Orchestra and Bowls Fellowship. They meet, practice and take part in a number of events, throughout the year.

Members with musical and bowls skills are warmly invited to join these sections.

The Annual Membership subscription is £15 payable on the 1st January each year covering 1st January – 31st December. You can, however, join at anytime of the year. Joining between April & July, it is reduced to £10.00 and between August & November to £5.00

Regrettably, with the much higher postage costs to Europe and Rest of the World, as against UK postage, **it is now necessary to add a postage supplement for new members living abroad.** For Europe it is £1.68 for a full year and, for Rest of the World, is £3.60

Your subscriptions and donations cover the cost of printing and posting the ONLOOKER magazine plus our Association administration costs. What is left over has enabled us to donate in excess of **£54,000** over the past 27 years, to the BB in London, Nationally and worldwide. There have also been other occasions when we have responded to appeals from major charities.

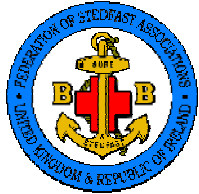
